He is currently appointed Director, Division of Basic Medical Research, Department of Basic Medical Research, the Japan Agency for Medical Research and Development (AMED). He has been the Representative of AMED to GloPID-R since August 2017.

He graduated from Master Programme in Veterinary Science, Graduate School of Agriculture, University of Osaka Prefecture, 1987 and joined the Ministry of Health, Government of Japan. He has been serving in the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare (MHLW), Japan for normative and regulatory works in food safety, infectious disease prevention and control, and International relationship and cooperation before his secondment to AMED.

He was seconded as Scientist to Division of Food and Nutrition, World Health Organization (WHO), Geneva from 1994 to 1997, appointed Counsellor, Permanent Mission of Japan to the United Nations, New York in 2008 and Director, Division of International Cooperation, the National Institute of Infectious Diseases (NIID), Japan in 2011. He was elected Vice President, the 43<sup>rd</sup> session of United Nations Commission of Population and Development, 2009.
