

Kenji Hirayama, MD, PhD.

Kenji Hirayama is a Professor of School of Tropical Medicine and Global Public Health and the Institute of Tropical Medicine (NEKKEN), Nagasaki University since 2001. He established the present NEKKEN during his deanship period between 2007-2011, 2016-2018. Kenji Hirayama graduated Tokyo Medical and Dental University (TMDU) in 1981 and got a PhD in the area of human Immunogenetics in 1985 and since then, he has been involved in a series of research on the genetic susceptibility against several parasitic infections, such as malaria, Chagas Disease, dengue fever, and schistosomiasis. He got awards from Japanese Society of Tropical Medicine (JSTM Award) and Japanese Society of Parasitology (Koizumi Award). He is also chairman of Forum for Ethical Review Committees in Asia and Western Pacific regions (FERCAP) since 2010.
